Rev David Fender's Message

There seems to be so much that's happening around the place, some of it you may have missed. Of course the most notable change has been worship service times. I've written a separate letter about this. Please take the time to read it.

Here though I wanted to share with you some of the other exciting things that have been happening.



Next Friday night will be their awards night. Unfortunately, this year due to COVID we can't issue a general invitation to be part of this.

We have had 5 of our young people finish high school this year. After a tumultuous year we celebrate with them and pray for them.

Throughout the year a group of us have met regularly in what has become known as the MEG (Mission Experiment Group). Over the year they have prayed, thought about the nature of mission and listened to God and each other. They have also studied the demographics of our neighbourhoods, listened to key community leaders and literally people on the streets and in the shops. All this has been leading them to ask where God would have them try an agile and responsive missional experiment that comes alongside people without creating a dependency. They are currently identifying what this could be.

We are in the early stages of planning for an Op Shop. We believe that an Op Shop could be a place of hospitality where we meet our neighbours, serve their immediate needs and gain a deeper understanding of how else we could come alongside them.

Our Resources Ministry Team have undertaken a detailed review of each of our church buildings, halls and houses to identify major and minor maintenance and capital improvement needs. The team recognises that we are at a stage where there is a lot of work that needs to be done on our buildings. With limited finances our team has prioritised what needs to be done across the whole congregation.

Some of us have commenced a journey called Building a Discipling Culture. Whilst not being a program, it is a method of discipleship that equips us in our discipleship to make other disciples. As we proceed, we hope to involve others. Instead of our usual Community Carols events, the organisers have this year chosen to hold a series of Nativity Events at each of our centres at which a gift bag would be developed that would share with visitors the details of our services. A living nativity will be staged in the evenings leading up to Christmas.

On top of this we continue with our regular and semi-regular activities. SAGE, Yeronga Men's shed, Brigades, JAFFA, Unite, Men's Breakfast, prayer meetings, pastoral care, Fellowships and small groups all continue to meet.

None of this could happen without the wonderful engagement of each one of you. Southside is not something that we go to, Southside is who we are. Through our participation and engagement, we make Southside what it is. So I encourage you to think and pray about what you believe God wants our church to be and then commit and act to making that so. In the past weeks I have been praying and thinking about what I want our church to be. As I look at all that is above I see one constant stream running through, that we will be a people who know the love of Jesus and are fully devoted in showing that love to each other, to our neighbours and to God himself. It is my deepest desire and greatest joy that each of you will grow in that love and find your own way of showing that love. Thank you for sharing this journey with me.

Southside UC friends in Christ

During the months of March through to the present, we around the world have been struggling in so many ways with the impact of the COVID19 pandemic. Apart from the obvious tragic loss of life globally, many have had their mental health affected. That has been my story. Of course, I am far from alone.

Starting early in March as COVID19 presented its face day after day, I found myself wrestling with it in so many ways. I started - often at weird and wonderful hours, writing instrumental pieces. Occasionally pieces with lyrics, but usually piano instrumentals - often stark and reflective; with occasional bursts of sunshine and thanksgiving. Yet they have been the exception. At this point in time close on 30 pieces have been written, manuscript and recorded; blogged and Facebook-posted. Just like the pandemic itself, I didn't see this coming.

With encouragement from Dale and others, I've published a book of most of those pieces, along with prose reflections and images - **SONGS OF SOLACE & SORROW - a pandemic journey**. Links to mp3 and YouTube clips are also offered.
