Church Council update

Over the past months the Church Council has given prayerful and careful attention to the future ministry leadership needs of our congregation. Council has been mindful that the three-year fixed term placement of David Fender concludes at the end of 2021, including the funding for this position by the Presbytery.

The Church Council has agreed that beyond the end of 2021, there continues to be a need for a ministry leader placement, similar to that currently occupied by David. We have come to this position recognising that Southside is still in a transitional phase and that it is essential for our continued missional growth to have continued leadership in some areas. For this reason, a position description for a Ministry Team Leader has been created.

Whilst there is currently a shortfall in available income to fund this position, the Church Council believes that the position can be funded. Council has determined that funding can come from our cash reserves and from the potential of the Op Shop, that is planned to be opened in July 2021. Budget planning by the Treasurer, Resources Ministry Team and Church Council has always recognised that a 5 year transition phase to achieve a balanced budget is required. The Church Council believes that this is a prudent approach to maximise the gains, and honour the pain, of our amalgamation.

The decision of the Church Council needs to be approved by the Presbytery of South Moreton. If this decision is approved our congregation will be able to begin the process of calling a minister. This will involve the preparation of a Congregational Profile; the formation of a Joint Nominating Committee (JNC); and meetings with potential ministers identified by the Synod Placements Committee. The Joint Nominating Committee will comprise a total of up to six people, coming from each of our four communities and two presbytery representatives. Once the JNC has identified a suitable minister, it will make a recommendation to a congregational meeting to call that minister to serve as our Ministry Team Leader. David Fender will be able to be considered.

It should be noted, that due to conflicts of interest, members of the ministry team were not involved in all of these decisions regarding the position description.
