Sunday 27 December there will be no face to face service at any of our centres. Usual weekly services will resume on 3 January.

To maximise our capacity there will be allocated seating at each Christmas service.

This will involve:

- you being allocated to a designated, and numbered seat in the same way as at a sporting event or theatre.
- A request that you wear a face mask only when entering and exiting
- No moving around and no standing for singing
- No physical distancing.
