I recently saw a picture recently of what was called "deconstructed vegemite toast." It was a plate that had on it, a couple of pieces of toast, a small container with some butter and vegemite smeared across the plate. It was everything that made vegemite toast, but not as we know it.



We are now doing deconstructed church. Everything that we're doing is church, but not as we're used to. We're still engaged in the mission of God in worship, witness and service. It's not what we're used to. The focus of church life has moved from the church buildings, to our homes, our phones and our computers.

And with this movement you become even more responsible for your own spiritual journey. You can choose to, or not choose to, participate in online worship. And I'm pleased to share that from the website statistics and informal feedback, you are choosing to maintain your practices of worship. At the same time, you can choose to engage in your personal spiritual disciplines. I know from talking to some of you that spiritual lives are active. You can choose to support the church financially. At a time when many of us are feeling a financial pinch, I'm pleased to share that people are finding alternative ways to give. People are making EFT payments, others are posting cheques to our office, others are going into bank branches and making deposits. You can choose to remain engaged or you can withdraw. I am so excited when I hear of the extensive work that you are doing in keeping in contact with each other. We are truly seeing the church at work.



In Romans 8:28 we read, "and we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." We would never choose this pandemic. We deeply grieve the pain that it has brought on people across our world. Yet, the good news of our redeeming God is that he can bring good out of this disaster. Through this event I am seeing God's good coming as we grow closer together as one congregation. I am seeing a renewal in people's faith and I am seeing people who are being kept close to God through the work of the Holy Spirit. This is all reason to praise God.

I'm also aware that we are seeing some of the dark side of the church at work. Some of us are feeling cut off from others and from God. I am deeply sorry if our systems (or lack of systems) have failed you. Please, can I encourage you to contact me, your Community Minister, or a trusted member of our congregation and share your needs. We may be socially isolated; we do not want to be relationally isolated.

History of Religions in Australia

At the beginning of May, Heather Griffin commenced an online course called the History of Religions in Australia. They have 15 people joining in, and a few expressions of interest for it to be offered at a different time for folk who are working. Heather may offer it again in an evening time slot when this current group finishes.

With each period they look at (they've just done convict Brisbane) they are able to see what was done well and what was done badly and why. The group was asked on Wednesday "If you had lived then, how could you have helped bring hope to the various people in convict Brisbane? For example, the Irish Catholic women, who, in order to survive, needed a male protector from among the soldiers. How would their need to survive, and the stated values of their faith (virginity being one) leave them feeling about their relationship with God? Are there people that they simply would not hear a word of hope from, because of who they were? How does this inform what SSUC is called to do in 2020?"

The type of discussions and learning that are taking place through this group are helpful in informing the mission of Southside and our understanding of the church in our current society.

Volunteering with Southside UC
