Church Council update

We met on 16 December at Mt Gravatt (our church council meetings meet on a rotating basis at each centre).

Our devotion was Janet Franklin's reflection on Jeremiah 31:31-34 from our Daily Advent Reflections. It, along with the many contributions by our Southside congregation, was received very warmly.

We requested Presbytery authorise Rev Lyn Burden to be placed as an Intentional Interim Minister from 1 February 2022.

We approved an extension of supply ministry for Malia Ma'u to 30 June 2022.

We requested the Presbytery Pastoral Relations Committee (PRC) to give permission for Malia Ma'u to preside at the sacraments (Baptism and Holy Communion).

We approved the Lievano family to stay at Orford St residence till their house being built is available.

We discussed our response to the newly instituted COVID mandates in QLD. We are exploring one of our Communities hosting a COVID-vaccinated only worship service. This will be confirmed in the new year, with promising signs it will be available on Sunday 16 January.
